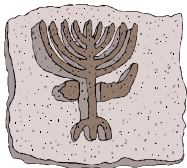


Image of an ancient menorah carving with a shofar. Jewish symbols when used for Jewish purposes.

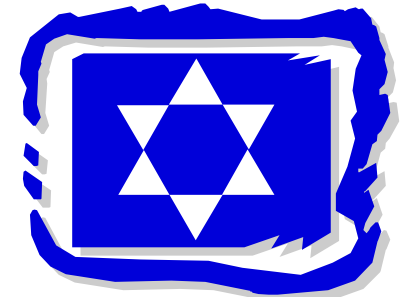
